Potters Knife

With a moulded plastic handle and a 60mm blade this multi-purpose knife is ideal for cutting, carving, paring and fettling.
Reference: PK1

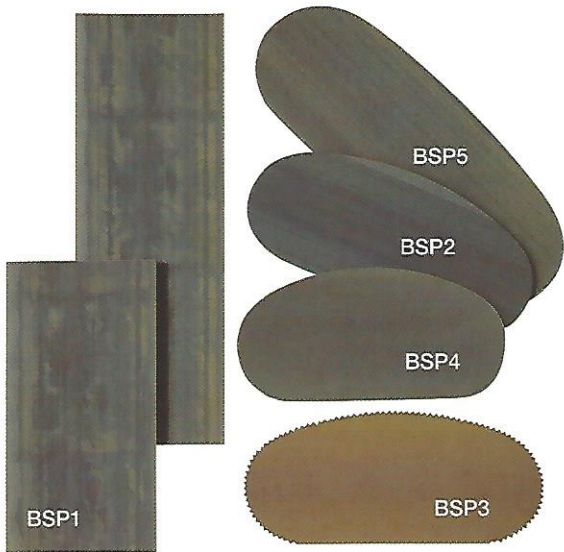
Fettling Knife

With a moulded plastic handle and a 60mm blade, this multi-purpose knife is ideal for cutting, carving, paring and fettling.

Hole Cutters

With a choice of several sized diameters from 2mm to 19mm and straight or tapered blade for varying sized holes, these cutters are useful for all pierced work. Manufactured from thin spring steel and sharpened along the edge to ensure an easy cut, the blade is semi-circular in shape to avoid clogging.
Reference: HC (straight)
TC (tapered)



Flexible Steel Palettes

Available in kidney or oblong shapes and various thicknesses and sizes, these are manufactured from flexible blued spring steel, hardened and tempered, and are useful for scraping, skimming, smoothing and chamfering clay plaster.



Coilers

With a comfortably shaped wooden handle, these are useful for the quick production of clay coils and with a sharpened edge on either side of the blade these are also suited for use in turning and fluting.
Available in three sizes.

Needles

Useful for trimming the height of pots whilst throwing and piercing small holes.
Available as thick or fine.
Reference: NF1 (fine), NT1 (thick)

Turning Tools

These tools have a ground cutting edge and cut-away shoulders allowing the user to achieve angles without interference with the article being turned. There are two widths, 11mm and 19mm and four different patterns to choose from - Square, Round, Leaf and Triangle.
Reference: SSTT1 - 4 (19mm) SSTT 5 - 8 (11mm)
